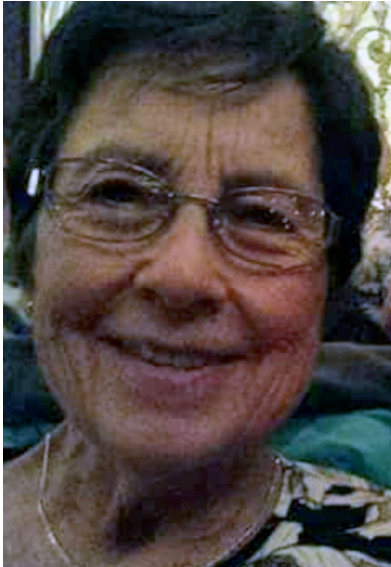


*Cynthia Basquin* January 7, 1952 - October 18, 2020
