**Gary L. McMillan**, 55, of Burlington, died at 10:32 a.m. Tuesday, Jan. 15, 2008, at Great River Hospice House in West Burlington.

Born April 21, 1952, in Burlington, he was the son of Robert Duane Sr. and Waunieta Dunn McMillan. On Nov. 9, 1995, he married Lori Stines in Keokuk.
