Michael E. Sink, Sr., 73, of Burlington, died Wednesday, September 25, 2024 at his home.

Born December 7, 1950, in Burlington, he was the son of Donald E. and Wanda Lee (Dile) Sink.

Michael graduated from Burlington High School and Trade School. He married Wilma Sickle Porter September 26, 1992 in Burlington and from this blended family, raised six children.
